I would say it's pretty definite that Paul George Ferdinando went by his middle name George. Henri Michaux, who worked for Charles Carrington (Paul Harry Ferdinando) in 1920, and then later ran the bookshop after Carrington's death, wrote in a 1971 letter concerning Carrington's family that 'George (I can only assume he was referring to Paul George) was a sailor in the English Royal Navy and that Fred served in the English Army and was living in Belgium at the time of his father's death.' I realize, though, that Fred's name is not part of the public record.

In another letter dated 1970 from a gentleman, who as a boy worked for Carrington, describes him as ".....very accentuated Anglo-Saxon type - sportsman - having practiced fencing and boxing - thick lips - speaking French with a strong English accent."

Carrington moved to France around 1895. Six years later he was expelled from France and then expelled again in 1907 due to his publications of 'indecent books'. (Report from the Joint Select Committee on Lotteries and Indecent Advertisements. London, 1908). Carrington moved to Bruxelles after his 1907 expulsion and did not return to France until sometime after April in 1912.

Basildon Park
Lower Basildon, Berkshire

The masterpiece of John Carr of York, this Palladian villa was built for Sir Francis Sykes between 1776 and 1783. It is a beautifully balanced building of warm Bath stone consisting of a main central block joined to individual pavilions by

single-storey linkages.

Sykes was the youngest son of a Yorkshire yeoman farmer who made a fortune working for the East India Company on the great Sub-Continent. He held many important posts including Factor & Chief of Kasimbazara and resided at the Court of the Nawab of Bengal, until ill-health forced him to return to England in 1768. He bought Basildon from the estate of Viscount Fane, three years later. Sykes was a close friend of Warren Hastings, the Governor-General of India, who lived at nearby Purley Hall and, along with a number of other 'nabobs' resident in the vicinity, he helped give Berkshire its reputation of being the "English Hindoostan". He was created a baronet in 1781.

Basildon was inherited by Sir Francis' grandson and namesake in 1804, when parts of the house were still incomplete. Unfortunately, Sir Francis Junior inherited massive debts from his spendthrift father and, in 1838, the estate was sold to James Morrison MP, one of the richest of the early Victorian merchant princes. He was a famous art-lover who became instrumental in the setting up of the National Gallery. He exclaimed of Basildon, "What a casket to enclose pictorial gems!". His architect, John Papworth, undertook a number of sympathetic alterations at the house between 1837 and 1842, after which the family took up full residence in the best of Victorian traditions.

The last of the Morrisons died in 1910, after which Basildon stood empty. It was used as a convalescent home for Berkshire regimental soldiers during the Great War, but subsequently fell into an increasing state of dilapidation. The estate was purchased by the 1st Lord Iliffe in 1928 in order to expand his Yattendon lands and the house was sold on to a George Ferdinando. This man had planned to have the place systematically demolished and re-erected in the United States! A scheme which, fortunately, never came to fruition, though many of the decorative fittings can now be seen in the Waldorf Astoria Hotel.

Miraculously, in 1952, Basildon was repurchased by Lord Iliffe's son and his new bride who set about restoring the place to its present splendour. Many fixtures and fittings were bought from other country houses whose fate was not so fortunate.

Basildon Park is the property of the National Trust and is open to the public throughout the Spring, Summer & Autumn.

Threats to Basildon Park in the 20th Century

Charles Morrison's nephew, James, inherited Basildon Park in 1910, but appears not to have lived there. Instead it was used as a convalescent home for First World War soldiers.

James - known universally as Jummie - invested in improving the estate, commissioning the architect Edwin Lutyens to design model villages in Upper and Lower Basildon. He used the estate for shooting parties, during one of which a paper company boss supposedly coined a new name for writing paper - Basildon Bond. A lavish lifestyle and three marriages later, his wealth had dwindled to £5,000 and the estate was put up for sale in 1928. He died in 1934.

Basildon was purchased by the 1st Lord Iliffe, a newspaper proprietor and publisher, who wanted to increase the land of his bordering Yattendon estate. Basildon house was sold as a speculative lot to George Ferdinando, a developer. He tried to sell the house to the United States, but failed, although smaller items were sold off, notably to the Waldorf Astoria in New York. He continued to own the house until after the Second World War.

For the next twelve years, Basildon became essential to the war effort and its

Generation 5 (con't)

aftermath, but was subject to a lot of damage. The park was used for tank practice and two American units completed training here before D-Day. After the war, the house was occupied by officers in charge of prisoners of wars, billeted in huts in the woods, then used by the Ministry of Works.

The house was eventually returned to Mr Ferdinando in a very poor state, needing extensive work while building materials were strictly controlled. The outlook for Basildon Park looked bleak

In 1936 G.S. Ferdinando lived (and/or worked?) at Audley House, Margaret Street, Cavendish Square, London W1. By 1939 his address had changed to Basildon Court, 27b Devonshire Street, Marylebone, London NW1.

PS Quentin dies 10/11/16 so the Ephorus article must be written after this date. Also there was a famous stoush in the VAS in 1917 which might explain Ferdinando's decision to resign.

On your website at <http://www.ferdinando.org.uk/artcile1.htm> you have a photo of Benjamin James Ferdinando. We think he is one of our 45 founding fathers, however our records differ somewhat from your website. We have a Benjamin James Ferdinando who was born in South England, arriving in Australia in 1880 at the age of 25 - this means he would have been born in 1855. do you think it's the same person? We were formed in Melbourne in 1886 & you say your person arrived in Melbourne the following year. Our details have been researched by academics who published their work - so I am pretty happy with their accuracy... Note the 1922 obituary says he was born 65 years ago, he would have turned 66 in the Oct of 1922 - so he was possibly born in 1856 - so very close to our information. What do you think? Is it him - a huge co-incidence. He was a founding father, but wasn't on our membership list

Some additional information for you: Benjamin was a Founding Father of the Incorporated Institute of Accountants, Victoria (IIAV), now known as CPA Australia. To be a founding father you had to be invited to the inaugural meeting by the Invitations Committee set up at a Preliminary meeting that was held to talk about the formation of accounting group in Melbourne.
